

USER MANUAL

The exclamation point within an equilateral triangle is intended to alert the user to the presence of important operating and maintenance (servicing) instructions in the literature accompanying the appliance.


IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS


- 1. Read these Instructions.
- 2. Keep these Instructions.
- 3. Heed all Warnings.
- 4. Follow all Instructions.
- 5. Do not use this apparatus near water.
- 6. Clean only with a dry cloth.
- Do not block any of the ventilation openings. Install in accordance with the manufacturers instructions.
- 8. Do not install near any heat sources such as radiators, heat registers, stoves, or other apparatus (including amplifiers) that produce heat.
- 9. Do not defeat the safety purpose of the polarized or grounding type plug. A polarized plug has two blades with one wider than the other. A grounding type plug has two blades and a third grounding prong. The wide blade or the third prong are provided for your safety. If the provided plug does not fit into your outlet, consult an electrician for replacement of the obsolete outlet.

- 10. Protect the power cord from being walked on or pinched particularly at plugs, convenience receptacles, and the point where they exit from the apparatus.
- 11. Only use attachments/accessories specified by the manufacturer.
- 12. Use only with a cart, stand, tripod, bracket, or table specified by the manufacturer, or sold with the apparatus. When a cart is used, use caution when moving the cart/apparatus combination to avoid injury from tip-over.



- 13. Unplug this apparatus during lightning storms or when unused for long periods of time.
- 14. Refer all servicing to qualified service personnel. Servicing is required when the apparatus has been damaged in any way, such as power-supply cord or plug is damaged, liquid has been spilled or objects have fallen into the apparatus, the apparatus has been exposed to rain or moisture, does not operate normally, or has been dropped.





The following parts are inlcuded:




Step #1: Assemble the Base


You will need:

- 20 pcs. x #1 Screws
- Base Left
- Base Right
- Base Back
- Top Shelf x 2 pcs.
- Bottom Shelf

Step #1: Attach Bottom Shelf to Base Left Step #2: Attach 2 Top Shelves to Base Left


Step #3: Attach Base Right







(1)-#1 SCREW

Step #4: Attach Base Back to complete Base assembly







Step #5: You can put the Base aside as you will not be needing it until the final assembly.


Step #2: Assemble the Marquee

You will need:


- 28 pcs. x #1 Screws
- Marquee Left
- Marquee Right
- Marquee Back
- Marquee Bottom
- Marquee Top
- Marquee Front
- Marquee Front Wall


Step #1: Attach Marquee Top to Marquee Left


Step #2: Attach Marquee Front




Step #3: Attach Marquee Right









Step #5: Attach the Marquee Bottom in as shown



Step #6: Attach the Marquee Back

2 ADULTS ARE REUQIRED FOR FINAL ASSEMBLY!


Step #1: Set the Main Housing on top of the base.

Step #2: Secure the Main Housing to the base using the #1 and #2 screws as shown.

Step #3: Set the Marquee on top of the Main Housing and secure it in place with 4, #2 screws and 2, #1screws as shown

- 1 #1 SCREW
- (2) #2 SCREW

Step #4: Attach the door as shown. 2 3 Inside of door 3-#3 SCREW P.9
