TECHNICAL TIPS

Testing Power Supplies with CTF-1

Using the variable power supplies on Atari's test fixture, CTF-1, you can duplicate the exact conditions of the PCB in the game. This is an advantage when testing for faulty regulated power supplies. To implement this test, first take the voltage measurement in the game before the AC signal is rectified. Adjust the variacs on the CTF-1 unit to that AC voltage. This will simulate the actual power conditions of the game. Hum-bars appearing on the built-in video monitor indicate a probable power supply problem.
