Special Service Bulletin From Nintendo of America Inc.

To: All Nintendo Distributors Re: Upper Coin Door Hinge

Problem

It's been discovered that a flattened straw or other similar objects can be put through the center opening in the upper hinge. The object can then make contact with the coin switch and run up multiple credits.

Solution

Mount a flange made of wood or metal to the inside of the cabinet (see drawing). The flange can be made by an operator; it is also available from us as a retro fit kit.

This problem is present in all Radar Scope Uprights, Donkey Kong Uprights, and the early shipments of Donkey Kong Junior Uprights.

Donkey Kong Uprights will have this flange incorporated in the machine starting with Serial Number 51800 for equipment made in the United States, and Serial Number 1121 for machines made in Japan.

Subject: Interchanging logic boards between upright and cocktail table games.

1. Logic boards with program #1 (first 1200 games) cannot be used in cocktail tables (upright and mini games only).

2. Logic boards with program #2 can be used in upright, mini- and cocktail tables (check dip switch setting for cocktail table).

Note: The #1 program factory difficulty level is 1 and program #2 is level 5.

Game: TRON Subject: Objectionable vertical line (lower right side of video screen). Modification

1. Adjust vertical center, vertical shift controls, and move objectionable line to the edge of video screen.

2. Check cycle game for correct boundary alignment.

Subject: Self-test bad ROM locations

1. When a bad ROM is located in self-test, the video screen will indicate location 02,

2. Due to computer type letters, this O is really the letter D, which locates a bad ROM.

3. To emphasize: What looks an O is really the letter D.

VICTORY HIGH SCORE FREEZE UP

On Victory you may encounter a rare phenomenon in which a player is putting his (or her) initials on the High Score Vanity Table and the game "freezes".

There are two methods of correcting this condition. One is to reset all the high scores to zero by:

1. Turning game OFF, wait 60 seconds.

2. Turn game ON.

3. Press red option button in coin door.

Enter into Option Select menu.

5. Select "Reset High Score Tables".6. Select "Exit Operator Interface".

The other option is to remove the batteries for the Battery Backup Memory like so:

1. Turn game OFF.

2. Remove batteries from audio PCB board.

3. Wait 60 seconds.

4. Insert batteries back into holders.

The preferred method is just zeroing the high player scores since it is easiest and also if you remove the battery all the preset factory settings are erased.

Rowe Phonographs **R81 to R83** Symptom

Reset light flashes when first number is pushed. Won't reset.

Solution

1. Check inputs on Z501 on Selector logic #601-08060. Pins 27 to 36 should be Q=17v, A=1v. If a low voltage is found on any of the inputs in the "Q" state, probably the bypass cap is bad, C506 to C515.

2. Replace with a .01E100v. Better yet, change all 10 of them.
