Field Service Bulletin Wild Riders Service Advisory Notice!!!! Verify Input Control Operation

SYMPTOM: Player controls may respond improperly, and players will not be able to perform all the tricks and functions of the game due to improper speed range etc....

SOLUTION: Perform 'Volume Adjustments' (See FIG A). Be sure to move all inputs (Steering / Brake / Accelerator) to their mechanical limits while in this test. Use Service Switch to move the arrow to 'Exit with Save' then press the Test Button. Exit out of the Test Mode fully and go to the Game Mode. Play game to verify proper operation.
