Set-Up Procedures



Opening the Cocktail Cabinet

Opening the Table Top




Figure 1-2A Game Overview—Cocktail Game

- To open the cocktail game cabinet, unlock the two key locks located immediately below the table top (see Figure 1-2A).
- Carefully lift the table top until the support arm locks into place. Do not jam the table top at the end of its upward swing.

Opening the Access Panel

- 1. Lift out the steel security bar that secures the panel to the cabinet wall (see Figure 1-2A).
- The access panel near the bottom of the cabinet will then come out.

Closing the Table Top

- Stand opposite the hinged end of the cocktail cabinet and grasp the table top with your right hand.
- With your left hand, hold down the button at the middle of the support arm and push the center of the support arm down.
- 3. Gently lower the table top to the closed position.
- Lock both key locks.

Cocktail Table Legs

This cocktail cabinet may be adjusted to tour heights—65, 70, 76, or 101 cm (25 ¾, 27 %, 30, or 39 ¾ inches). Adjust the table height as follows:

- 1. Remove or empty the coin box to prevent loose coins from sliding out of the box and into the game cabinet.




Figure 1-2B Adjusting the Table Legs

- 2. Lay the table on end as shown in Figure 1-2B. Place a support (the coin box, books, or tool box) under the recessed side of the cabinet.
- 3. Remove the two Allen-head screws on each leg.
- 4. Grasp the legs and slide them into the desired position. Then replace the screws.

- CAUTION -

To ensure cabinet strength, you must use two screws to attach each table leg. Using only one screw may damage the cabinet wall when moving the cabinet across the floor.




Figure 3-2A Cabinet-Mounted Assemblies Cocktail Game A040310-01 A+





Figure 3-2A Cabinet-Mounted Assemblies, continued Cocktail Game A040310-01 A+




Figure 3-8A Video Display Assembly Cocktail Game A040315-01 A




Figure 3-9A Utility Panel Assembly Cocktail Game A037866-01 A


