TO REMOVE CARD CAGE.

- 1) Open Card Cage door.
- Slide the cage out carefully, but DO NOT attempt to pull it all the way out yet.
- 3) When connectors (at the rear end of the cage) become visible disconnect the following connectors from the PC Boards:

50 PIN I/O PC Board

40 PIN Laser Disc Player

7 PIN Audio

6 PIN Video

RCA Plugs (2 each) Audio

15 PIN DC Power

RCA Plug Video

- If necessary, the PC Boards can be rotated to provide access for removal of connectors by loosening thumbscrew stops, both top and bottom.
- 5) Cage can now be carefully removed.

- Engage cage in bottom guides.
- 2) While supporting cage (with bottom of cage resting on bottom guides), reconnect connectors mentioned in removal procedure. PC Boards may be pivoted to provide access.
- Engage top guides, and slide card cage into the enclosure.
- Secure all thumbscrew stops to hold PC Boards in place (both top and bottom).

NOTE: Please excercise great caution to insure that no cables are damaged.
